### 1 Introduction

---

We are looking for a dynamic freelance filmmaker and photographer who will help us tell the stories and document the activities of [Voices Gloucester](#).

### 2 Background

---

Voices Gloucester has a year-round programme, created by people from every walk of life who share a passion for storytelling and a deep sense of pride in Gloucester's history and heritage. Content produced is recorded and added to our growing project portfolio, to preserve Gloucester's rich and diverse heritage.

Stories are portrayed creatively in a range of formats from historical talks to works of art, from theatre to spoken word, from poetry to podcasts. The content created can be a live event or digital content, showcasing new and sometimes challenging perspectives on Gloucester's history and heritage and provides the opportunity to connect with others in the community.

Anyone can get involved. We have an open grants scheme where you can apply for funding to support the story you want to tell. Projects are selected by a Community Panel, creating a truthful and representative collection of voices for current and future generations to hear.

### 3 Brief

This will be a varied role attending a range of events and supporting us in creating content to promote, showcase and preserve a diverse range of activities and events.

We are looking for someone who is excited about the potential of working with individuals and communities who may not previously have had their work or stories celebrated.

You will be capable of creating a range of documentation, including:

Short films for social media across digital platforms,

At least one longer film to 'tell the story' of Voices Gloucester.

Photography that can be used both for social media, and stored for archives.

### Essential

Demonstrable experience of delivering a range of documentation films and photography, ideally within the creative industries or a cultural/heritage setting;

### Desirable

Experience of working with Archives.

## 5 Fee and Application Process

This is a fixed term contract until September 2024, with an inclusive fee of £10,000. The successful applicant will agree a timetable and outputs with the Voices Creative Director and Marketing Lead.:

Your approach : How will you ensure that you tell the complex stories of Voices activities? Will you have a particular style of photography and film? How will you support Voices participants?

Your availability : How many events/ films would you expect to provide? How you would expect to allocate your time?

This is a freelance opportunity and applicants will need to be responsible for their own tax and national insurance.

**Application process** To apply please submit your CV and a proposal which includes:

- An outline of your approach to telling Voices Gloucester stories; how you would expect to allocate your time over the 15 months
- Links to relevant previous work
- 2x referees
- Anything else you feel relevant to support or add value to your application.
